The purpose of this report is to present the responses from the RCMP with respect to the questions raised by City Council regarding the Mayor's Gala detailed cost analysis at the Regular Council Meeting of April 26, 2021.

At the Regular Council Meeting of April 26, 2021, City Council considered the Report to Council, dated April 20, 2021, from the Chief Administrative Officer regarding the Mayor's Gala Detailed Cost Analysis. 1. *How much of the Mayor's Gala overtime costs were allocated to the Township of Langley?*
2. *Why is there a significant discrepancy between the Gill report and the RCMP report on taxpayer costs, one saying \$8,100 and one saying \$361.44?*

3. *Why did it take over one year to receive a response from the RCMP?*
4. *Why was the former OIC of the Langley detachment Superintendent Murray Power reassigned?*
