
Dear Mr. Green,

On September 6, 2013 City Council was advised that the Board of Education had been going through the process of developing a new School Site Acquisition Charge. The letter further advised that the Board of Education intended to adopt the Eligible School Site Proposal report at its September 24<sup>th</sup> meeting. The adoption of that report set in motion a 60 day period for City Council to either accept or reject the proposal. Please be advised that at the October 21, 2013 regular council meeting Langley City Council adopted the following resolution:

1. THAT City Council inform School District No. 35 that the City rejects the proposed new School Site Acquisition Charge.
2. THAT City Council request that School District No. 35 create a separate School Site Acquisition Charge for the City of Langley based on Alternative 3 of the Urban Systems July 31, 2013 letter ("Re: Alternative SSAC as Requested by City of Langley") where the City contributes only to the acquisition of secondary school sites.

It is the desire of Council to work with the Board to find a solution that is mutually beneficial for both parties. I look forward to working with you to that end.
