Hi Anton,

Thank you for the referral regarding the proposed OCP Amendment in support of a six-storey apartment development at 20040-20070 53A Avenue and 20041-20071 53 Avenue.

Upon review, we can confirm that the subject property is located in the General Urban regional land use designation in *Metro 2040*, the regional growth strategy. As residential development is permitted, no amendment to *Metro 2040* is required.

We note that the proposed OCP amendment would add a new Low Rise Residential designation for residential development up to a maximum density of 2.10 FAR. We are also pleased to see that the development is located in Langley Regional City Centre. For these reasons, the proposed development supports several Strategies in *Metro 2040*, including:

- Strategy 1.2 – that encourages growth into designated Urban Centres and Frequent Transit Development Areas
- Strategy 5.1 – that supports the coordination of land use and transportation and encourages transit, multiple-occupancy vehicles, cycling and walking
