EXPLANATORY MEMO

CITY OF LANGLEY SIGN BYLAW, 1996, No. 2125 AMENDMENT No. 7, 2022 No. 3219

The purpose of this bylaw is to:

- update definition of “Political Sign Area” for greater clarity;
- add definition of “City-owned Boulevard”;
- change the location of one of the permitted Political Sign Areas where Political Signs may be placed on public property;
- include a location map of the two Political Sign Areas in the Bylaw as a schedule to the bylaw; and
- update descriptions for the Political Sign Areas.

A Bylaw to amend the City's Sign Bylaw.

The Council of the City of Langley, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Title

This bylaw shall be cited as the "City of Langley Sign Bylaw, 1996, No. 2125, Amendment No. 7, 2022, No. 3219".

2. Amendments

(1) Sign Bylaw, 1996, No. 2125 is hereby amended as follows:

(a) In Section B – Definitions:

- i. by replacing the definition of "Political Sign Area" which reads as follows:

"Political Sign Area means a public area designated in section 4 of this Bylaw for the placement of Political Signs."

with the following:

"Political Sign Area means the City-owned Boulevard in the locations identified in Section 4(h)(v) of this bylaw and as shown in Schedule "C" attached to and forming part of this bylaw for the placement of Political Signs."

- ii. by adding the definition of "City-owned Boulevard" as follows;

"City-owned Boulevard means that portion of highway between the face of the curb and the adjoining property line or, on a highway without curbs, that portion of highway between the edge of the roadway and the adjoining property line."

(b) In Section C – General Provisions, by replacing subsection 4(h)(v) as follows:

“v) are placed in the following designated *Political Sign Areas* with the consent of the owner or occupier:

- 1) B.C. Hydro Right of Way along both sides of 200th Street (legally described as Lot 528, District Lot 37, New Westminster District, Plans 62262 and 62263; South Half of Lot A, District Lot 37, New Westminster District, Plan 7062; Section 35 Township 7, New Westminster District Part NW ¼, Plan 7062 except Plan PCL B EP8068; PCL A RP 7062, 20662, 289,28, 44016, 46874 and 49277); and
- 2) 5795 Langley Bypass (legally described as Lot 67, District Lot 37, New Westminster District Plan 57552).”

with the following:

“v) are placed only in the designated Political Sign Areas described as follows and as shown in Schedule “C” attached to and forming part of this bylaw:

Site 1) B.C. Hydro Right of Way along both sides of 200th Street.

Site 2) East side of Langley Bypass from the corner of the exit out of Langley Twin Rinks to the beginning of the entrance turning lane to Kwantlen Polytechnic University.”

(c) By adding Schedule “C” to the bylaw, as attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
