COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

THAT, if required, Council authorize the purchase of T-Shirts for the “Block Walk” Program in the amount of \$300.00.

SUMMARY:

On May 26, 2022, at the Crime Prevention Committee meeting, the group finalized plans to attend the June 18, 2022, Langley Community Days. The group will be promoting the “Know Your Neighbour” campaign and the related “Block Walk” program. The “Block Walk” program is a new initiative where volunteers will walk the streets of Langley City neighborhoods, engaging citizens and promoting Crime Prevention programs. Members of the Crime Prevention Committee will recruit volunteers for the “Block Walk” program” at the Community Days event. The “Block Walk” program is tentatively scheduled for the third week in July.

Members of the Crime Prevention Committee would like the volunteers for the “Block Walk” program to be outfitted in t-shirts, similar to the ones that were purchased previously for the “Know Your Neighbour” campaign. Currently there are a limited number of t-shirts available and already purchased for new volunteers. It is unknown if the current stock of t-shirts will suffice. As such, The Crime Prevention Committee is recommending that if required, Council consider purchasing t-shirts for the new volunteers. T-shirts are approximately \$15.00/each. If an additional twenty shirts were required, the approximate cost would be \$300.
