## PURPOSE:

The purpose of the report is to seek Council's support of the Community Grant Committee recommendations regarding the distribution of the community grant.

## POLICY:

Community Grant Policy CO-51

**COMMENTS/ANALYSIS:**

The City has allocated \$168,000 to provide community grants to organizations that contribute to the general interest and advantage of the City.

**BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:**

The grants requested for the second intake with an application deadline of June 30, 2022, totalled \$47,980 from 11 organizations of which \$37,510 was identified for distribution. During the first intake, \$114,558.19 was awarded in February 2022 resulting in a total of \$152,068.19 being awarded in 2022.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

Council could alter the amounts of the grants being considered and/or approve other grant requests.
