## COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

**THAT** Council approve up to \$10,000 from the public art fund to be used on a mosaic mural (north wall) and a painted mural (east wall) on the Rotary Centennial Park washroom building incorporating the theme of flight and movement.

---

## SUMMARY:

On June 21, 2022, at the Arts, Recreation, Culture and Heritage (ARCH) Committee meeting, the group finalized the discussion on the two murals at the Rotary Centennial Park washroom building, north and east walls. A member of the committee has connected with Maker's Cube to discuss the mosaic mural on the north wall (288" wide x 94" tall) which will include the theme of flight and movement.

The painted mural to be located on the east wall (152" wide x 94" tall) will also have a theme of flight and movement recognizing the flight paths of birds and planes in the area, as well as movement from one place (country) to another, and transitions of people in the area.

The painted mural on the east wall will be a call to artists, while the north wall will be a collaborative effort with the community. The ARCH Committee will work collaboratively with the Maker's Cube, Langley Community Services Society and the community surrounding the park to engage participation with the mosaic mural.

Currently there is \$40,451 in the public art fund; there are no outstanding projects attributed to this funding source.
