1. THAT Tender T2022-011, 46 Avenue Storm Sewer be awarded to Klondike Infrastructure Ltd. based on the tendered amount of \$549,124.68 (excluding GST).
2. THAT Council Authorize the Director of Engineering, Parks and Environment and the Corporate Officer to execute the contract document for T2022-011, 46 Avenue Storm Sewer to Klondike Infrastructure Ltd.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the report is to seek authorization from Council to award the tender T2022-011, 46 Avenue Storm Sewer to Klondike Infrastructure Ltd.

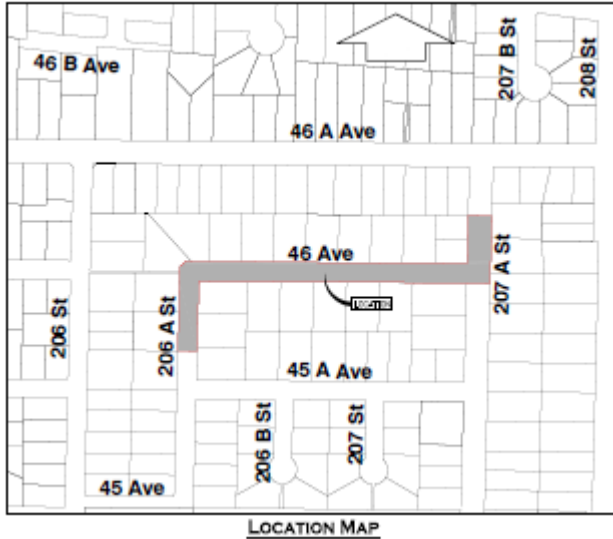
POLICY:

Purchasing Policy FN-12- City Council approval required for entering contracts for goods or services over \$375,000.

COMMENTS/ANALYSIS:

The tender T2022-011, 46 Avenue Storm Sewer was advertised on BC Bid. It includes the construction of a new replacement 300mm perforated storm sewer on 46 Avenue between 206A and 207A Street including manholes, services and new catch basins.

Seven (7) quotes were received with Klondike Infrastructure Ltd being low bid:

The tenders were reviewed by the City's consultant Binnie Engineering for completeness, errors, and compliance to the tendering specifications. Klondike Infrastructure Ltd. was found to be the low compliant bidder.
