# LANDSCAPE NOTES

- 1. For all grading information REFER TO CIVIL.
- 2. For zoning, vicinity map and legal information REFER TO ARCHITECTURAL
- 3. For the dimensioned Site Plan REFER TO ARCHITECTURAL.
- 4. For all layout and centreline information REFER TO ARCHITECTURAL and CIVIL.
- 5. Lighting to be at safety levels with accent lighting in key areas REFER TO ELECTRICAL.

# IRRIGATION NOTES

- Irrigation to be provided for all 'Soft Landscape Areas' shown on the drawing.
- Irrigated areas to be installed as a design build irrigation system from the stub outs provided. Provide submittals of design to consultant at least one week prior to installation and as-built drawing within one month of substantial performance.
- The irrigation system design and installation shall be in accordance with the Irrigation Industry of BC Standards and Guidelines.

# **PLANTING NOTES**

- All work shall meet or exceed the requirements as outlined in the Current Edition of the Canadian. Landscape Standard.
- 2. Plant sizes and related container classes are specified according to the Current Edition of the Canadian. Landscape Standard. For container classes #3 and smaller, plant sizes shall be as shown in the plant list and the Standard, for all other plants, both plant size and container classes shall be as shown in the plant list. Specifically, when the plant list call for #5 class containers, these shall be as defined in the CNLA (ANSI) Standard.
- 3. All trees to be staked in accordance with CNLA Standards.
- 4. Tree caliper shall be a minimum of 6cm.

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
