PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to seek endorsement from Council to forward approved Council resolutions to the Lower Mainland Local Government Association (LMLGA) for consideration of endorsement at this year's LMLGA Conference.

POLICY:

The prescribed format for resolutions to be considered by the LMLGA is as follows:

- Resolutions must be regional in nature and relevant to other local governments;
- No more than two Whereas clauses;
- No more than one sentence in each Whereas clause; and
- Each resolution must have its own backgrounder, which is not to exceed two pages.

COMMENTS/ANALYSIS:

The 2023 LMLGA Convention and AGM will be held May 3, 2023. The submission deadline for resolutions for consideration of endorsement at the convention is March 3rd.

The UBCM requests that any resolutions which Council wishes to submit to the UBCM for consideration at its annual convention first be forwarded to the appropriate Area Association for consideration, which for the City is the LMLGA. Resolutions endorsed at the LMLGA convention are submitted automatically to UBCM for consideration and therefore, do not need to be re-submitted to UBCM.


BUDGET IMPLICATIONS:
