## **Policy:**

- 1. Elected officials will abide by the requirements imposed by Provincial legislation concerning ethical standards of conduct.
- 2. Elected officials will not:
  - (a) use information designated as confidential for the person personal profit of themselves or any other person;
  - (b) communicate information designated as confidential to any person who is not entitled to receive it; or
  - (c) use their position to secure special privileges, favours or exemptions for themselves or any other person.
- 3. Elected officials will:
  - (a) avoid any situations that could cause any person to believe that they have brought bias or partiality to a matter before the Council;
  - (b) abide by this policy for a period of 12 months after leaving office;
  - (c) abide by the provisions in this policy concerning confidentiality in perpetuity.
- 4. Elected officials will not assume that any unethical activities not covered by or specifically prohibited by any legislation or this policy are condoned.
