Policy:

1. Elected officials will abide by the requirements imposed by Provincial legislation concerning ethical standards of conduct.
2. Elected officials will not:
 - (a) use information designated as confidential for the person personal profit of themselves or any other person;
 - (b) communicate information designated as confidential to any person who is not entitled to receive it; or
 - (c) use their position to secure special privileges, favours or exemptions for themselves or any other person.
3. Elected officials will:
 - (a) avoid any situations that could cause any person to believe that they have brought bias or partiality to a matter before the Council;
 - (b) abide by this policy for a period of 12 months after leaving office;
 - (c) abide by the provisions in this policy concerning confidentiality in perpetuity.
4. Elected officials will not assume that any unethical activities not covered by or specifically prohibited by any legislation or this policy are condoned.
