RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council award Tender T2023-002, 2023 Sanitary Trenchless Repairs Various Locations to Mar-Tech Underground Services Ltd. based on the tendered amount of \$650,564.87 (excluding GST).
2. THAT Council authorize the Manager of Engineering Services to execute the contract document for Tender T2023-002.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to seek authorization from Council to award the tender T2023-002, 2023 Sanitary Trenchless Repairs Various Locations.

POLICY:

Purchasing Policy FN-12: City Council approval required for entering contracts for goods or services over \$375,000.

COMMENTS/ANALYSIS:

The Tender T2023-002 for the 2023 Sanitary Trenchless Repairs was advertised on BC Bid. The construction package related to this Contract consists of trenchless point repairs to the existing sanitary sewer system to address sanitary sewer deficiencies identified in the 2022 sanitary sewer remote camera inspection report and analysis. The trenchless repair method utilizes existing access chambers to access the underground system and perform the repairs from the inside of structures without the need of excavation. The pipe repairs consist of tree root removal, grease removal,

pipe grouting, manhole grouting, lateral grouting, debris removal etc. The trenchless repairs consist of 270 pipe sections throughout the City at a cost which is about half of the \$1.4 million budget allocated for the 2023 Sanitary and Storm Repairs. The other remaining half of the budget will be used for the open cut excavation sanitary and sewer point which will be tendered at the end of April 2023.

The Contract work is expected to start in May 2023 and be completed by November 2023. Minimal traffic impact is anticipated but where needed the contractor will maintain traffic flow with traffic control personal.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject Contract were opened on April 13, 2023 with the following results:

EVALUATION

The City reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond and were signed on the Tender Form. The Tender Submissions were based on construction being permitted for 120 working days from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday as per the City's Noise Bylaw No. 2628 allowable day-time hours.

Mar-Tech's past performance on similar work has been satisfactory and they have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Mar-Tech Underground Services Ltd. be awarded Contract No. T2023-002.
