MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION SYSTEM BYLAW, 2011, No. 2846, AMENDMENT No. 19, 2023, No. 3212

PURPOSE:

The purpose of Bylaw No. 3212 is:

1. To update Schedule A (Enforcement Officers): In reference to "Schedule B26", to add a list of City staff with the required authority to enforce the proposed Sanitary Sewer and Storm Sewer Regulations Bylaw, 2023, No. 3210; and
2. To add Schedules B26 to reflect the proposed Sanitary Sewer and Storm Sewer Regulations Bylaw No. 3210 section references and fines.

A Bylaw to amend fees in the Municipal Ticket Information System.

1. Title

(1) This bylaw shall be cited as the “Municipal Ticket Information System Bylaw, 2011, No. 2846, Amendment No. 19, 2023, No. 3212.”

2. Amendments

(1) Municipal Ticket Information System Bylaw, 2011, No. 2846 is hereby amended by:

- (a) Deleting Schedule A – Enforcement Officers and replacing it with a new “Schedule A – Enforcement Officers” attached to, and forming part of this bylaw; and
- (b) Adding “Schedule B26 – Sanitary Sewer and Storm Sewer Regulations Bylaw” attached to, and forming part of this bylaw.
