RE: Request for Endorsement of CKF Inc.'s Capital investment in Greater Langley

CKF is a privately held, Canadian family-owned company, now in its fourth generation. CKF has succeeded in its 90 years of operation because of its dedication to customers, quality production, innovation, and its commitment to environmental stewardship. We are proud of where we're from. Our six Canadian plants (four in British Columbia) serve the entire globe, offering a wide range of moulded pulp fibre, RPET/PET (Polyethylene Terephthalate (PET) containers made with post-consumer resin (PCR), referred to as RPET) and foam products for Packaging, Retail and Food Service.

CKF is planning an ambitious capital investment project that will use both innovative and established technologies to produce more recyclable products, improve productivity and competitiveness of existing product lines (by increasing output and reducing manufacturing costs) and improve the sustainability of our manufacturing processes (by optimizing energy and material inputs).

Over the next 7 years we want to expand our manufacturing of PET and Pulp in Langley, B.C. as follows:

1. PET Capacity – We will notably increase our PET manufacturing capacity towards the goal of 800 million trays per year. This includes the purchase of new equipment, consolidation of existing equipment, large investment in axillary and infrastructure, and expansion of warehousing space.
2. Pulp Moulding Capacity – We will significantly increase our pulp molding capacity, which will include a building expansion of 27,000SF and a sizeable investment in new equipment to produce state of the art pulp trays using the latest pulp molding technology.
3. Research and Development – We will be investing in the development of PFAS free moisture and grease barrier for molded fiber products.
4. Property Expansion – The above projects will require property and electrical expansion in Langley to support business growth.
5. Job Growth - The direct results of these investments will be the securing of existing manufacturing jobs at the B.C. plants as well as the addition of fifty to ninety-five new jobs associated with the new production lines.

CKF currently supports 350 employees and their families on the West Coast. We will significantly expand our capabilities to service the West Coast with pulp and PET based products, predominately meat trays. The expansion of PET manufacturing will lead to increased consumption of recycled PET which will go back into newly manufactured finished product. Failure to invest in this expansion will result in products being imported from the US and Offshore, impacting local employment and increasing costs of these Pulp and PET trays.

What are we asking for? For the above reasons, we are requesting your official endorsement of our capital investment plans in the Greater Langley Area.
