EXPLANATORY MEMO

Highway and Traffic Regulation Bylaw, 2013, No. 2871, Amendment No. 7, 2023, No. 3258

The purpose of this bylaw is to:

1. Amend Section 7(2) in reference to Extraordinary Traffic Control on Heavy Truck Routes to include wording to restrict parking on any highway not designated as a Heavy Truck Route. This amendment will enhance enforcement legislation for Heavy Truck parking in residential and other areas not on a designated Heavy Truck Route.



**Highway and Traffic Regulation Bylaw, 2013,
No. 2871, Amendment No. 7, 2023, No. 3258**

A Bylaw to amend wording in the Highway and Traffic Regulation.

1. Title

(1) This bylaw shall be cited as the “Highway and Traffic Regulation Bylaw, 2013, No. 2871, Amendment No. 7, 2023, No. 3258.”

2. Amendments

(1) Highway and Traffic Regulation Bylaw, 2013, No. 2871 is hereby amended:

(a) In Section 7. Extraordinary Traffic Control, subsection (2) Truck Route, by replacing the first paragraph which reads as follows:

“No person shall drive or operate a heavy truck on any highway in the City except those highways set out in Schedule A of this bylaw (herein called the “Truck Route) except:”

With

“No person shall drive, operate, or park a heavy truck on any highway in the City except those highways set out in Schedule A of this bylaw (herein called the “Truck Route) except:”.
