Wildfire	Description	Value
S-100	The S-100 is a two day, 16-hour course with both a classroom and a field component. The annual refresher is a one-day, four-hour course and does not include a field component. Upon successful completion of the course, the candidate will demonstrate a basic knowledge of wildland fire suppression organization structure, wild fire behavior, and suppression and safety procedures.	45 members at \$250.00 = \$11,250.00
S-185	S-185 course, the participant will be able to size up and evaluate potential fire entrapment situations and how to act accordingly to remove himself or herself safely from a potentially risky situation, deploy the necessary resources using safe and efficient strategies and tactics to prevent loss of life.	12 members at \$250.00 = \$3,000.00
Wildfire Risk Reduction Basic Course	FireSmart BC's Wildfire Risk Reduction course is for non-forest professionals who are interested in wildfire risk reduction, or are engaged in FireSmart BC programs. This includes those working for local governments or First Nations, those involved in emergency response, and anyone looking for funding to improve their community's wildfire resilience. Local FireSmart Representative	The newly updated LFR workshop was developed by the Partners in Protection Association to assist participants in becoming familiar with and implement all components of the FireSmart Canada Neighborhood Recognition Program (FCNRP). The training provided in this virtual workshop equips Local FireSmart Representatives with an understanding of current Wildland Urban Interface concepts and wildfire hazard assessments. It provides them with the tools and skills necessary to recruit and motivate volunteer community leaders, and mentoring abilities to work with self-organized groups of citizens as they plan and implement wildfire mitigations in their own neighbourhoods. FireSmart 101	Provides an introduction to FireSmart and its principles, helps participants understand the need to protect homes and properties from wildfire, helps participants understand the need to protect homes and properties from wildfire, defines the wildland urban interface, outlines the seven FireSmart disciplines and explains the FireSmart the home ignition zone.	Program offered by FireSmart BC
Palmer Dollhouse Ventilation Prop	This Doll House is made out of steel and has steel slides for window and roof covers. We will supply enough burn materials for 2 burns after which after you will need to supply the burn material for inside the house, (7/16 OSB, works very well) You can purchase more window and roof covers if they become damaged or make them your self out of wood.	\$6,750.00
Fire Life Safety Educator	Members will gain knowledge and skills to deliver sound public education to their communities. They will explore the myths and realities of fire, human behaviour during fire emergencies and strategies to effectively reach a variety of audiences. Methods of delivering fire and life safety education, selecting educational materials, working with the media and evaluating program success will also be covered. Upon successful completion of this course and Fire Service Instructor I (S101), students will receive a certificate with ProBoard and IFSAC seals for NFPA 1035 Professional Qualifications for Public Fire and Life Safety Educator Level I.	\$4,927.80
