RECOMMENDATION:

THAT council direct staff to investigate the viability and associated cost to implement a mural at:

Location 1: City Hall – NE Entrance wall and as an alternative,

Location 2: McBurney Plaza – SE wall (facing west) and potentially consider installation of a crime prevention vehicle wrap as outlined in the attached report.

SUMMARY:

In March of 2023, the Crime Prevention Committee (CPC) created a Mural Sub-Committee to work on ideas to support the creation and location of a potential crime prevention themed mural in the downtown area of Langley City.

On October 25, 2023, at the CPC meeting the sub-committee presented a report (attached) on potential locations for a crime prevention mural. The report summarized seventeen potential locations, scoring each on several criteria. The CPC members reviewed the report. Members voted on potential locations, identifying the following as the top two:

Location 1: City Hall – NE Entrance wall and as an alternative,

Location 2: McBurney Plaza – SE wall (facing west) and potentially consider installation of a crime prevention vehicle wrap as outlined in the attached report.

Location 2 also recommends considering the installation of a vehicle wrap of a City of Langley vehicle with crime prevention messaging.

The CPC now recommends that Council direct staff to investigate the viability and associated costs to implement a mural at the identified locations and the potential for a vehicle wrap.
