Please advise City Council that Langley Volunteer Bureau has subscribed over 70 charity and nonprofit organizations to connect with almost 3,500 registered volunteers on our website (www.langleyvolunteers.ca). Langley Volunteer Bureau recruits volunteers for fundraisers and community events. This summer Langley Volunteer Bureau enlisted over 400 volunteers for the 3 day RibFest event, hosting about 44,000 attendees and raising tens of thousands of dollars for grants and scholarships in the Langley community. Currently, Langley Volunteer Bureau is distributing Cards for Seniors. This program provides card-stock, crafts and envelopes to school children who create individual holiday greeting cards for seniors, many living in isolation. Now, Langley Volunteer Bureau is introducing the Snow Angels Program to help clear and de-ice public walkways at residential properties for Langley residents who are senior in age or physically challenged.
