FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY BYLAW

No. 2788

A Bylaw to provide for the administration of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.

The Council of the City of Langley, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. **Title**

This bylaw shall be cited as the “Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw, 2009, No. 2788”.

2. **Definitions**

- (1) “Act” means the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*”; and,
- (2) “City” means the City of Langley.

2. **Enactment**


- (1) The Corporate Officer is designated as the Head of the City for the purposes of administering the *Act*.
- (2) The Deputy Corporate Officer is designated as the Coordinator of the City for the purposes of administering the *Act*.
- (3) The Corporate Officer and, in her absence the Deputy Corporate Officer, must perform the duties of the head specified in the *Act*.
- (4) The head may require a person who makes a request for information for those records routinely available under the *Act*, without a request for access under the *Act*, to pay the applicable fee set out in the City’s Fees and Charges Bylaw.
- (5) The head may require an applicant who makes a request for information for those records that are available pursuant to a request under the *Act*, and not exempted from disclosure under the *Act*, to pay the applicable fee set out in the City’s Fees and Charges Bylaw.

3. **Severability**

- (1) If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.
