

EXPLANATORY NOTE

SOLID WASTE BYLAW, 2016, No. 2991, AMENDMENT No. 8, 2024, No. 3299

The purpose of Bylaw No. 3299 is to increase the municipal garbage collection service fee by \$120 in 2025.

The City of Langley has entered a new 7-year contract for solid waste collection services. The new contract has extended the existing service until April 30, 2025 to facilitate a smooth transition to the new methodology and collection system which will include semi-automated collection with wheeled collection carts for garbage and organics. The rate increase of \$120 includes the increased cost of the new service, increased disposal fees from Metro Vancouver and the prorated cost of the two carts which will be supplied to each household receiving the service.

The flat fee (2025) will increase to \$391 (an increase of \$120 or 44.3% over 2024).

Amendment

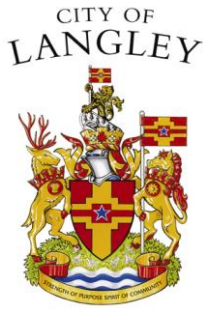

SCHEDULE “A”

Every Owner of a Dwelling Unit receiving Municipal Garbage Collection Services provided by the City is required to pay the amount of \$391.00 per year. For new construction, the charge shall be pro-rated for the first year of service according to the actual number of months that the service is provided.
